

High School “To Do” List:

Senior:

- Take college required courses, preferably two AP/Honors classes.
- Confer regularly with your counselor.
- Take or retake the SAT and or ACT in the fall.
- Take the ASVAB as a Junior or in the Fall of Senior year if going into the Military
- Attend post-secondary information events and financial planning workshops.
- Narrow down your post-secondary choices.
- Write personal statements and college entrance essays.
- Send out college applications in the fall.
- Obtain teacher and counselor references in advance (by junior year!).
- Take achievement tests, if the colleges you are looking at require them.
- Create a checklist and calendar to chart
- Create a financial aid profile
- Make sure that test scores have been sent directly to your college
- Complete your FAFSA (financial aid) on October 1st.
- Check monthly scholarship lists and apply.
- Check your transcript with your counselor.
- Request counselor to send transcript to your college/university choice.
- Take English and Math tests for college placement if needed.
- You are allowed to verbally commit to a school anytime.
- Official visits to schools should continue.
- Sign your letter of intent in fall or late spring.
- No Senioritis – remain committed to school!
- Send your college commitment and deposit
